LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS

CONSTRUCTION WORKS AT SEAVIEW YACHT CLUB ISLE OF WIGHT
MAY-OCTOBER 2014

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that construction works have started on a replacement landing stage and extended slipway to Sea View Yacht Club, Isle of Wight. The existing slipway will be replaced by a new slipway immediately adjacent to the east which will extend beyond the end of the existing slipway by an additional 20 metres (50 43.321N 01 06.593W).
2. New timber piles will be driven into the foreshore to construct the extended slipway and the piles will be submerged at high tide. The two furthestmost seaward piles will be marked with temporary red warning buoys during the works.
3. It is expected that the temporary buoys will remain in place for at least two months. Construction works will temporarily cease on 16 July 2014 and recommence on 26 August 2014, with estimated completion by 31 October 2014.
4. Mariners are warned to keep clear of the construction site, particularly at high water when obstructions may not be fully visible.
5. Cancel this Local Notice to Mariners 30 November 2014.
