
**LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No 44/14**

**PORTSMOUTH REGATTA 28 - 29 JUNE 2014**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** by the Queen's Harbour Master Portsmouth that the Portsmouth Regatta will take place in areas to the south of Portsmouth Harbour on Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 June 2014. The regatta is organised by the Royal Albert Yacht Club, the Victory Class and Portsmouth Sailing Club. Vessels participating will include several classes of Day boats, IRC and Club Class Cruisers. A total of around 100 vessels is expected to take part in the various classes.
2. The Regatta will be held in the areas as indicated on the diagram. IRC/NHC Cruiser racing will take place in the "Eastern Racing Area" to the south of Southsea and to the east of the submerged barrier. Day boat racing will take place in one or two of the three other designated areas, depending on the weather conditions prevailing on the day. Permanent racing marks will be used where possible to mark courses, but temporary racing marks will also be laid. Race committee boats will include the "Condor" and "Mary Siobahn", and the Race Officers will be contactable on VHF Channel 72. VHF Channel 11 will also be monitored.
3. The racing areas will be active on Saturday 28 June from 1030-1700 and on Sunday 29 June from 0900-1500. QHM, Wightlink and Hovertravel will be informed of which Day boat racing areas will be active at the start of each day.
4. In addition to the committee boats, a number of other safety boats will be in each area to assist the race control teams and assist competitors if required.
5. Support boats will also be available to tow non-engine fitted craft in and out of harbour using the Small Boat Channel, with pick-up areas to the south of Ballast Beacon and to the west of BC(Outer) pile, clear of the Boat Channel itself.
6. Competitors are reminded of the need to consider other traffic in the area, and have no special status in regard to the Collision Regulations. This is particularly pertinent with regards to commercial traffic using the Swashway into or out of Portsmouth Harbour.
7. All mariners are requested to keep a good lookout and pass well clear of the racing areas if practicable.
8. Cancel this Local Notice to Mariners 30 June 2014.
