Mariners are advised that to facilitate dredging in the Nab Channel the following stations are to be temporarily relocated as follows:-

1.1 Station : N1 Lighted Buoy.

Position : Latitude 50° 40'.915N., Longitude 000° 56'.296W.

1.2 Station : N2 Lighted Buoy.

Position : Latitude 50° 40'.832N., Longitude 000° 56'.606W.

1.3 Station : N4 Lighted Buoy.

Position : Latitude 50° 42'.049N., Longitude 000° 57'.362W.

1.4 Station : N5 Lighted Buoy.

Position : Latitude 50° 42'.006N., Longitude 000° 56'.906W.

2. Date : On or about 16th July. 2014.

2.1 Station : N3 Lighted Buoy.

Position : Latitude 50° 41'.643N., Longitude 000° 56'.680W.

Further notice will be given upon completion of dredging activity when all stations have been re-located to their assigned positions.
