**LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS**  
**No 61 / 14**

**EASTNEY CRUISING ASSOCIATION REGATTA 9/10 AUGUST 2014**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** by the Queen's Harbour Master Portsmouth that the Eastney Cruising Association will be holding their annual Regatta on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 August 2014. The majority of events will take place in and around the entrance to Langstone Harbour, outside of the Dockyard Port of Portsmouth, or will be smaller scale yachting or dinghy sailing races. However, there are three key events that mariners should be particularly aware of.
2. A Water Skiing event will take place in Langstone Harbour entrance in the period 1830 to 2030 on 9 August. The Langstone Harbour Master has relaxed the 10 knot speed limit for participants only. Other mariners should exercise caution in this area.
3. A power boat race will take place from 1530 to 1615 on 10 August. The start will be in Langstone Harbour Entrance, proceeding to the Langstone Fairway marker, leaving the marker to port and returning to Langstone Harbour entrance. A maximum of ten boats is expected to take part. The 10 knot speed limit in the Dockyard Port of Portsmouth is relaxed for participants only, and only while they are competing in the race. Competitors have no priority over other vessels, and normal COLREGS apply. Safety boats will be on hand, and will be listening on VHF Channel 37.
4. During the afternoon of 10 August at approximately 1630 there will be an organised swim across Langstone Harbour entrance to the ECA clubhouse. Vessels navigating in the vicinity at this time should exercise extreme caution. Again, safety boats will be in attendance.
5. Cancel this Local Notice to Mariners with effect from 11 August 2014.
