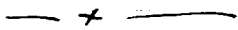

An overtaking boat must pass on the port side of the boat he is passing and must not consider he has overlapped until he is a boat's length ahead.

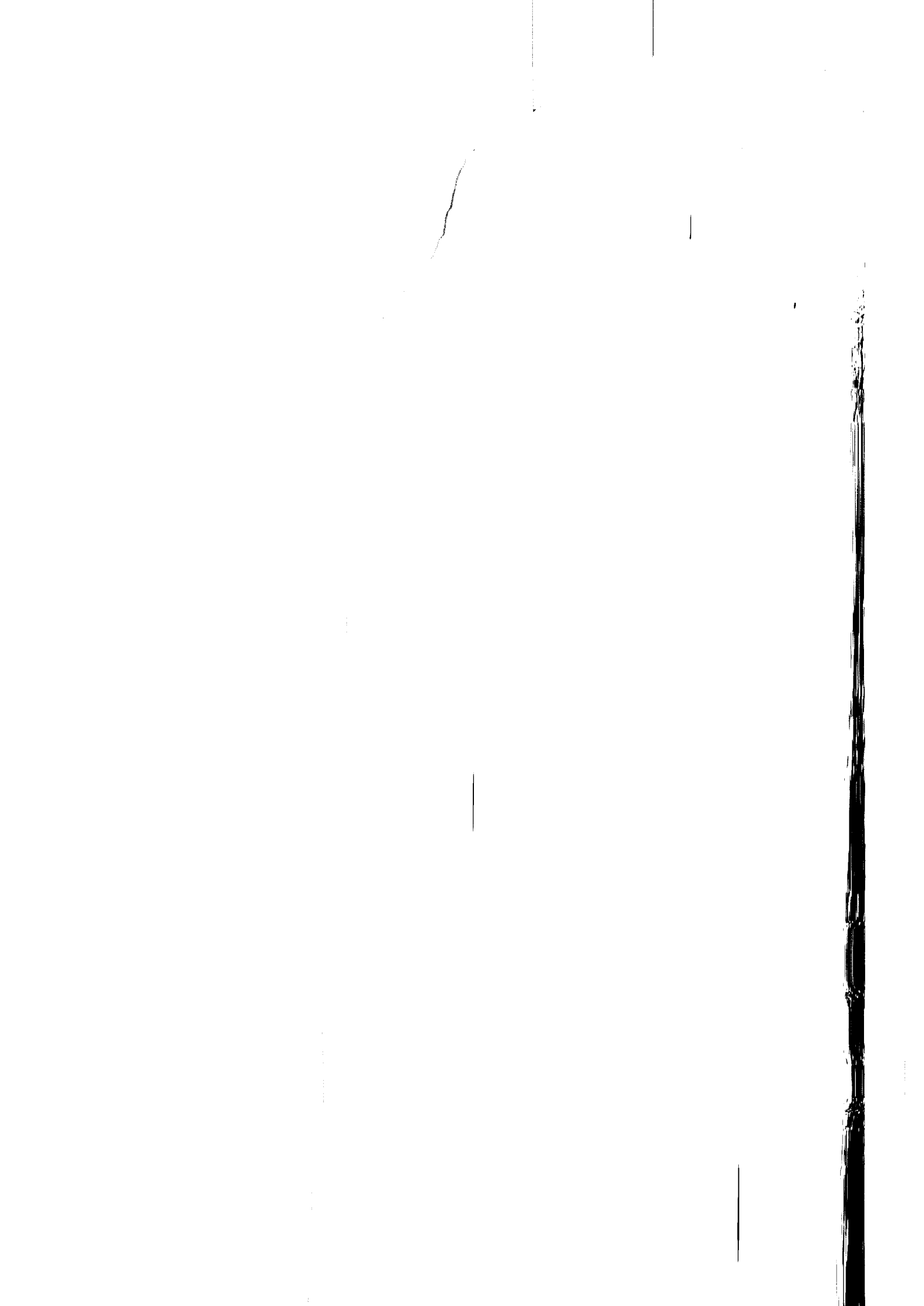
